

Floridsdorf: Niklas Schneider starts in the 2nd league!

Niklas Schneider moved to Floridsdorfer AC from Bregenz in 2025 after playing at the FCM Traiskirchen.



Bregenz, Österreich - An exciting news from the football scene: Niklas Schneider provided a fresh wind at the Floridsdorfer AC (FAC). The 21-year-old, who previously shone at the FCM Flyeralarm Traiskirchen in the regional league Ost as a regular player of the defensive, signed a contract until summer 2026. "I am really looking forward to the challenge and the conversations with those responsible went great," emphasizes Schneider in a first statement. The step to the FAC represents a significant further development for him, and specialist Lukas Fischer, managing director of sport, emphasizes his great potential.

The new player comes from the picturesque Weinviertel in

Lower Austria and started his career at the UPS Schrick. He finally found his way to Traiskirchen through the Admira Wacker academy, where he was able to prove himself with 27 competitive games last season. reinforcements for the coming season

The Floridsdorfer AC has drawn a solid new addition to the 2nd division with Schneider to be well prepared for the upcoming competition in the 2nd league. Schneider is the second newcomer to the club, according to Edin Huskovic. "We have proven a good hand for the new additions," says Fischer. The change also takes place with regard to the departures, especially after the goalkeeper of SV Stripfing has switched to FC Bregenz and is required on the defensive reinforcement. Schneider should now play a central role in both central midfield and in central defense, where he has already shown promising services.

The transfer activities around the 2nd league also show that the clubs are in an exciting phase. According to the current data from [Transfermarkt.at] (<https://www.transfermarkt.at/2-liga/transfers/wettbewerb/a2>), the league records a total of 312 departures with a transfer balance of around 780,000 euros. In comparison, 310 entrances were registered. This play of movement shows that the clubs work actively on their squads to be well prepared for the new season.

The coming months will be decisive for the Floridsdorfer AC to assert themselves in competition. With talents like Niklas Schneider you rely on a mixture of fresh wind and experience. According to the previous developments, the fans are looking forward to what the new season will bring, and you can be

excited to see how the team will be under the new leadership.
